

November

- 3 No classes; faculty in-service day
- 15 One week of remote schooling**
(Boarding students may depart campus.)
- 20 Full day of classes (all remote).

Thanksgiving break begins after classes. All students depart by noon on Nov. 21, and remain off campus until January.
- 21-30 School is closed for Thanksgiving recess
- 30 No classes; faculty in-service day

December

- 1 First semester resumes; remote schooling period begins
- 18 Last day of first semester classes
- 19 Winter break begins; no classes
- 21-31 School is closed for the holidays

Second Semester

January 2021

- 1-3 School is closed
- 4-10 School offices are open
- 11-24 **Second semester begins; remote schooling period for all students.** (See Jan. 11 and Jan. 18 weekly schedules.)
- 16-17 Boarding students return for a one-week quarantine period on campus.
- 25 Classes follow the updated hybrid weekly schedule: in-person and remote. The weekly schedule for the second semester was updated in order to increase flexibility for students who need to switch between in-person and remote learning.

March

- 12 Full day of classes for all students; spring vacation begins after classes
- 13-29 Anticipated spring vacation (While a two-week vacation is planned, this may be changed to one week if conditions warrant.)
- 29 No classes; faculty in-service day
- 30 Second semester classes resume on campus

May

- 24-27 Preparation days for final examinations and assessments
- 27 Last day of second semester classes
- 28 Final examinations and assessments begin
- 31 Memorial Day holiday (No classes held)

June

- 1-3 Final examinations and assessments
- 4 Academic Awards and End-of-Year Celebrations
- 5 Class of 2021 Commencement
