Interest in or experience with IB science is a plus. Candidates with instructional coaching and/or leadership experience is a plus. Minimally, this candidate will have a Bachelor of Science in either biology or chemistry. A Master's degree, teaching credentials, and/or relevant teaching experience are preferred.
