

## Packing List

### What will be in my room when I arrive?

Each room is equipped with a twin bed frame, mattress, desk, chair, small trash can and recycling bin, closet/bureau, personal safe, overhead lights, and window shade. Some dorm rooms are fully carpeted. Most rooms house two students with limited singles in some dorms.

### What should I pack to bring to my dorm room?

#### For your bed:

- Pillows
- 2 Sets of Pillowcases and Sheets (twin - XL)
- Comforter, Extra Blankets
- Mattress Pad (twin - XL)

#### For your room:

- Laundry basket and/or clothes hamper
- Laundry detergent, dryer sheets, stain remover
- USA approved surge protector (non-surge protector power strips are not allowed)
- Small fan
- Desk lamp
- Water bottle
- Extra storage (i.e. under-the-bed, stackable cubes, etc.)

#### For the bathroom:

- 2-3 towels
- Washcloths/luffa sponge
- Shower shoes (i.e. flip flops)
- Shower caddy

- Toiletries (i.e. soap, shampoo/conditioner, lotion, face wash, razors, shaving cream, deodorant)
- Oral hygiene products (i.e. toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss)
- Hair care products
- Bathrobe

**For your closet:**

- Clothes hangers
- Clothes for school (i.e. presentable academic wear, spirit wear, formal wear)
- Workout clothes & gear
- Casual clothes
- Sleepwear
- Weather-related outerwear (i.e. winter jacket, rain/snow boots, hat, gloves, etc.)
- Umbrella
- Lint roller or brush

**For your schoolwork:**

- Laptop and/or iPad w/ keyboard & chargers
- Notebooks and folders
- Bookbag
- Pens, pencils, highlighters
- TI-Nspire calculator
- Headphones
- Glasses/contacts
- Desk supplies (i.e. scissors, tape, sticky notes, paper clips, etc.)

**Personal items:**

- Driver's license and/or passport
- Wallet (including debit/credit card, other ID's, medical insurance, etc.)
- Photos, cards/letters, etc.
- Posters (with Command strips for hanging)
- Books, movies, music
- Snacks
- Cell phone and charger(s)
