IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

In 2024, 19 IB Diploma Programme candidates earned the IB Diploma. They also fulfill three requirements: The Extended Essay; Theory of Knowledge; & Creativity, Action, and Service. Participation is based on inquiries from students and recommendations by department chairs. All students taking an IB course must complete the IB exams.
